

Non-Core Subjects Assessment Policy

This Assessment Policy provides a framework for the evaluation of students' progress and achievement in non-core subjects: Music, Arts, PE, Humanities, French, PSHE, Drama, ICT/Computing, and Design and Technology. The policy is designed to align with the National Curriculum for England (NCE) and the Ministry of Education (MOE) in the UAE, ensuring that assessment practices are effective, fair, and meaningful.

Objectives

- To assess and monitor students' progress across all non-core subjects.
- To provide clear, constructive feedback that supports students' development.
- To ensure alignment with national standards and curricula.
- To use rubrics for consistent, objective, and transparent evaluation across subjects.
- To create an inclusive and comprehensive assessment framework.

Assessment Structure

For all subjects, rubrics will be used to measure students' performance against clearly defined criteria, ensuring transparency and consistency. Rubrics will focus on specific learning outcomes for each subject, in line with National Curriculum for England and UAE Ministry of Education requirements. Assessment will be both formative (ongoing) and summative (end-of-term).

Assessment Categories & Rubrics for Non-Core Subjects

1. Music

Purpose: To assess students' skills in performing, composing, and appraising music.

- Learning Outcomes:
 - o Perform musical pieces individually and in groups.
 - Compose original music or pieces based on given themes.
 - Listen to, appraise, and critique music in a reflective manner.

2. Art

Purpose: To assess students' creativity, technique, and understanding of art principles.

Learning Outcomes:

- Apply artistic techniques to create original works of art.
- Explore and use various media (painting, drawing, sculpture).
- Reflect on the impact of art in society and culture.

3. Physical Education (PE)

Purpose: To assess students' fitness levels, skills, teamwork, and understanding of sportsmanship.

- Learning Outcomes:
 - o Demonstrate basic physical fitness and coordination.
 - o Participate in team and individual sports.
 - Understand the importance of healthy living and physical activity.

4. Humanities

Purpose: To assess students' understanding of history, geography, and society.

- Learning Outcomes:
 - o Understand historical events, geographical features, and cultural influences.
 - Analyze sources of information critically.
 - o Demonstrate knowledge of current events and their societal impacts.

5. French

Purpose: To assess students' proficiency in listening, speaking, reading, and writing in French.

• Learning Outcomes:

- o Demonstrate understanding of French vocabulary, grammar, and culture.
- Effectively communicate in French in speaking and writing.
- o Interpret spoken and written French accurately.

6. Personal, Social, Health Education (PSHE)

Purpose: To assess students' understanding of emotional wellbeing, relationships, and societal issues.

- Learning Outcomes:
 - Understand and apply principles of emotional wellbeing.
 - o Develop interpersonal skills and respect for others.
 - Address social and ethical issues confidently.

7. Drama

Purpose: To assess students' ability to perform, collaborate, and understand dramatic techniques.

- Learning Outcomes:
 - o Demonstrate performance skills in individual and group settings.
 - o Apply knowledge of dramatic techniques and genres.
 - o Critically reflect on performance.

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8. ICT/Computing

 - o Understand internet safety and ethical computing.

- Evaluate and improve technological products.
