

Uniform Policy

Our school uniform at DePS is part of our identity and all students should take pride in wearing it. The aim of our uniform is for students to present a neat, work-like appearance at all times and to take pride in being members of Deira Private School. Personal presentation is very important and a high standard of personal appearance is expected of all students at all times.

The uniform is compulsory throughout the school and may be purchased from the school store. Please ensure all uniform items are clearly labelled with the child's name and class. Name tapes are excellent or alternatively a waterproof marker pen.

As per the behaviour policy, an incorrect uniform will lead to sanctions after persistent warnings. And as from the beginning of the new academic year, the management will be holding uniform checks to ensure all children are following the policy. All children will receive a warning the first time as well as the incorrect uniform (jackets) being taken away until the end of the day. After the first warning, children will receive after-school detention as per the behaviour policy.

We would appreciate your support and guidance with the children's correct uniform. Below mentioned are the details of the School Uniform-

FS1 and FS2 Boys - Blue Polo T-shirt with Navy Blue Shorts or Pants Girls - Blue Polo T-shirt with Tartan Skirts or Pants

Year 1 Boys - Blue Polo Tshirt or Buttoned Shirt with Navy Blue Shorts or Pants Girls - Blue Polo Tshirt or Buttoned Shirt with Tartan Skirts or **Pants**

Years 2 to 8 Boys - Blue Buttoned Shirt with Pants Girls - Blue Buttoned Shirt with Tartan Skorts or Pants

P.E. Day: students should wear school P.E. Uniform. No other tracksuits etc. are permitted. Please look at your class timetable to know about your scheduled P.E. days.

School Jackets

Only School jackets are permitted. They are available at the school uniform store, it can be procured on any of the working days between 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Shoes and Socks:

Smart Black School Shoes and White Socks are mandatory on regular school days. Non marking White Sports Shoes with White Socks should be worn for PE days as per your child's timetable.



Hair, accessories and hair colour:

Girls – Hair should be tied back fully off the face. The sensible use of hair accessories is acceptable to keep hair orderly and neat e.g. Alice band, hairband, clips, slides, elastic bands, scrunches etc. as long as they are plain white, dark blue or black.

Boys - Hair must be well off the collar at the back and off the ears and face, no shorter than a number two barber cut. Shaved heads are not acceptable. We request no coloured gel, wax or mousse etc. be used when styling hair and no exaggerated styles.

All Students – We request that hair must be of a natural colour. Coloured hair is not permitted. If the students' hairstyle contravenes any of the above requirements the student will be requested to amend this with immediate effect.

Hair should always be neatly tied if longer than shoulder length.

Jewellery

Students may wear a watch however SMART watches that can connect to the internet will not be permitted.

Girls may wear one small ear stud in each ear lobe. No other piercings are permitted. No other jewellery is allowed.

Make up

Make-up and nail polish are not permitted at DePS.

School Bags

TROLLEY BAGS are NOT permitted due to Health and Safety reasons.

Trolley bags cause children to twist their backs for extended periods with their shoulders and arm stretched behind them just to manage the bags. They are also a tripping hazard. Considering health and safety, we request parents not to send trolley bags along with the children.
